Get a Job

Your fake job will give you a description of the job, pay rates and a weekly roster. (In reality, casual jobs won't give you the same hours each week which sucks for trying to budget.)

Use your fake job's details and fill out the "Time Sheet and Net Income.docx" to work out your gross and net pay

Page 1

Create your first page. It should include the following information

- Description of the job
- How often you work
- How much you get paid (per week, fortnight and year)
- How much you pay in:
 - o Supperannuation (9.5% of your gross income)
 - o Tax (see https://www.ato.gov.au/Rates/Individual-income-tax-rates/)
 - o Medicare Levy if relevant (2% of gross income)
- How much you have left over to spend (This is your net income)

Budget 1

The money you have left over will be called **Budget 1**.
